Because we will in effect not have had a SNOB meeting for two months because of our fantastic Christmas Party and the Sumerian Beer presentation at **GLBC at 6:30PM on January 6**, we have some important items to focus on so I will take this time to give you all some things to think about and even participate in before our next meeting in February.

We have a new beer event coming to Cleveland called the **Cleveland Winter Beerfest** put on by the same folks who do the successful Cincinnati and Columbus Beerfests. The Cleveland Winter Beerfest will be held on January 31 and February 1 from 6:30 till 11:00 PM each night at the new Cleveland Convention Center. As with anything beer in Cleveland, they are coming to the SNOB's for volunteers. They need about 150 volunteers per night and you can sign up at <http://www.clevelandbeerfest.com>. Let's show them some love and help them out and get a chance to be a part of the first ever beer festival in the new convention center.

I've already been asked if this is going to happen and the answer is, yes. The SNOB's, under the direction of Paul Shick will be putting on BJCP study sessions to help prepare us for taking the written BJCP exams. These 2-3 hour study groups to be held on a day of the week TBD in Jan and/or Feb will be held at either or both MGBC and/or GLBC on Wed evenings at 6:30 or 7:00 PM. I highly recommend taking part if you are interested in learning more about how to brew better beer. We will pass around a sign-up sheet at the January meeting for those interested.

The **8th annual Winter Warmer** is coming up on March 1 and will again be held at the Windows on the River in the Flats. Put it on your calendar and volunteer to help out, it is a great event to be a part of.

A little further down the road but coming up quickly is the **Beer No Sweat Bus Trip**. We would like to see a show if interest so we can determine the cost per person and make sure we have hotel rooms for all. Last year we did a 14-hour bus trip to and from PA, visited many great brewery's and had a GREAT, GREAT, GREAT, GREAT time. John Majetic has jumped in early on and the 2014 BNS will be a two day, that's right, TWO-day trip to Indiana. We will leave on April 12 around 8AM, hopefully with kegs of homebrew occupying one seat and hit all the good breweries along the way until we get sleepy. The hotel is already booked and the next morning we will continue our brewery tour, working our way back home, arriving back by around 11PM on Sunday. Believe me, this is a great way to unwind and escape from life's pressure for a couple days, you will have a GREAT time. We will pass around a sign-up sheet at the January meeting for those interested.

Lastly, but maybe most importantly is **NHC**. This "could" be the last time the NHC is held in the Midwest for who know how long. This year, it will be held on April 12th thru the 14th in Grand Rapids, MI. We had more fun than should be legal last year in Philly and are sure to repeat in 2014. **Mark your calendars and check your checkbook**. This will cost between \$145 and \$205 per person plus food and lodging to attend but is well worth it. Also, start thinking about brewing for the NHC competition, first round shipping is approximately March 10th to 17th. 
