Last year I supplied Hoppin' Frog Brewery with 40 pounds of fresh hops for their annual wet brew. This year I have close to the same amount of hops but every other local grower without irrigation had near complete crop failures. Even Seattle has gone 40 days without rain. I have Cascade, Nugget and Centennial that should mature in the next 2 weeks.
